AFTER MONTHS OF ADVOCACY, RESOLVE TIBET ACT IS SIGNED INTO LAW

As we go to print, the Promoting a Resolution to the Tibet-China Dispute Act (called the Resolve Tibet Act) has just been signed into law by President Biden. We are thrilled by this legislative victory, and so appreciative of our members' efforts to support the passage of this bill!

In a statement, ICT President Tencho Gyatso thanked supporters and emphasized that China must resume dialogue with the Tibetans, saying, "I hope Beijing will now see that this dispute must be resolved through negotiation, instead of an assault on Tibet's unique and ancient civilization."

This law will strengthen US efforts to push the Chinese government to resolve the longstanding Tibet-China dispute through dialogue with Tibetan leaders. It passed with overwhelming bipartisan support.

NEW REPORT: CCP GIVES BUDDHIST ASSOCIATION OF CHINA LEADING ROLE IN RESHAPING TIBETAN BUDDHISM

In a new report we released May 29, 2024, we show how the **Buddhist Association of China** (BAC)-the main organization representing Buddhists in Chinais becoming a key instrument in the Chinese Communist Party's (CCP) strategy to transform Tibetan Buddhism and bring it under government control. We found that since President Xi Jinping's announcement of his intent to "Sinify" the PRC's religions in 2012, the BAC is being used to implement these campaigns in Tibet.

Our findings show that CCP strategy is to make Tibetan Buddhism conform to government ideology, including by establishing specialized "training institutes" for Tibetan Buddhist clergy.


But the most critical impact would be BAC interference in the search for reincarnate lamas. The CCP has assigned BAC a role in recognizing and training CCP-selected "reincarnations." This step will be important to the Chinese government's longterm strategy on controlling the reincarnation process and installing a false "Dalai Lama" the ultimate act of religious suppression.

Tibetan Youth Leadership Program (TYLP)

The 2024 Tibetan Youth Leadership Program brought 10 talented Tibetan American college students from across the country to Washington, DC this June for leadership training in activism and advocacy. This annual program hosted by ICT helps nurture young people to become leaders of the Tibetan community in the future, and to harness their energy and convictions about issues affecting Tibet into a powerful force for change.

Through workshops, discussions, and hands-on activities, participants learn more about the Tibetan context and develop their knowledge and confidence in becoming successful youth organizers. We are excited to see what the future holds for this energetic group of intelligent, thoughtful Tibetan American leaders! Thank you for helping make this popular program possible.

Washington Internship Program for Tibetan Americans (WIPTA)

Each summer, WIPTA provides 2-3 Tibetan American undergraduate or graduate students with an opportunity for a summer internship placement in US Congressional offices or other agencies in the heart of the US political system in Washington, DC. Part of ICT's efforts to empower the burgeoning Tibetan American community, the WIPTA program offers meaningful opportunities and exposure to the US political process and public policy firsthand.


WIPTA participants are known as "Lodi Gyari Fellows" in honor of ICT's former President and Chair of the Board of Directors Lodi Gyari.
